Borders

We have met with both the South African and Botswana authorities in an attempt to smooth the process and have had fantastic support from the Botswana side but mixed from the South Africans.

At Dundee, after the race, we will be distributing:

- The Botswana arrival forms so that you do not have to queue for them on arrival at the border.
- A “pre list” for you to compile a comprehensive list in the correct format for presentation to SARS first and then BURS second. This can then simply be attached to the CE65 form.
- A form that can be completed and emailed to us with your payment for us to pre buy your road taxes for your vehicle and trailer. We will have these ready for you at the border (Tlokweng or Swartkopfontein) when you arrive and thus speed up your passage through the border. Unfortunately we are unable to do the large trucks as these have to be assessed by BURS at the Botswana border.

If you do not get the Arrival forms from us send us an email with how many you need and a physical address and we will try to get some to you. The other two forms can be downloaded from our website (www.toyotadesertrace.co.za) as well.

Please remember that you need for the SAPS for ALL vehicles and trailers:

- A copy of the registration papers.
- A letter from the registered owner, finance house etc giving you permission to take the vehicle out of South Africa if you are not the registered owner.

I hope that this will make your trip to the TDR 2011 that much easier and more enjoyable.
